During this powerful campaign we will approach the Bible in a chronological fashion, placing Bible events in their historical order as we attempt to see how God is writing His story across history. Each week we will look at a number of passages of scripture. A reading list which includes all of the passages of scripture we will be engaging during each week of the campaign is available at the OCC Life Center and in the church office. These guides make it easy for folks to follow along in their favorite translation of the Bible. For convenience and ease of access. we are also making available copies of the devotional tool entitled "The Story." In The Story, the Bible reading for each week has been reprinted directly from the NIV Bible into a devotional tool formatted so that readers complete one chapter of The Story for each week of the campaign. Each chapter also includes brief commentary by author Max Lucado to move us from one historical event to the next in an

informed way. (The suggested donation for a copy of The Story is \$8.50, however, if this cost is prohibitive, OCC is happy to provide you with this resource at no cost.) Whether you read the texts from your own Bible or if you read those same Bible passages reprinted in The Story, the important thing is that you are reading God's story and coming to understand the big picture of how it all fits together.
