A rose is purchased and presented to the family in honor of each newborn baby and each new family member receives a special at-home visit where a certificate is presented along with a baby Bible. In addition, each family receives a monthly card until the child is two years old and has therefore graduated to toddlerhood. Thirty-seven children have already graduat-

ed from this program since its inception, the oldest now six years old! Ten babies are currently enrolled and three are awaiting their home visit. To recap, OCC is at baby number fifty since 2008 with at least four more on the way!

This program is in place for all babies under the age of two, even if the family was not attending OCC at the time of their child's birth. We want to make from Norm & Marijane Love



A pancake fundraiser will be held at Applebee's in Seymour this Saturday, November 2nd from 8-10 a.m.




